Cybercrime is an offensive and unethical attempt that occurs on or through a computer, the internet, or another piece of technology that has been approved by the Information Technology Act. The most pervasive crime that has a severe impact on contemporary India is cybercrime. Numerous unlawful actions are carried out by technically proficient criminals on the internet. If we apply a broader definition, we can say that cybercrime is any illicit conduct that uses a computer or the internet as a tool, a target, or both.

The term "cyber security" refers to a set of technologies, processes, and practices that are designed to protect networks, devices, programs and data from digital attack, damage, or unauthorized access. Cybersecurity basically is divided into two words: cyber, which means "Any Data directly or indirectly related to computers," and security, which means "protecting various types of Data from being misused." Terminologies such as computer security or IT security are aliases for Cybersecurity fundamentals.

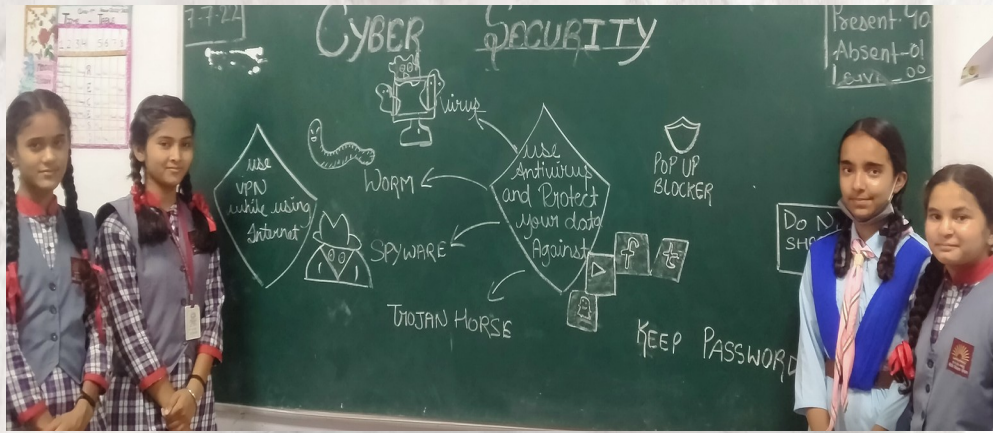
Essay on "Cyber Security"
